Green Initiatives

- Hotel participates in Marriott's Connect Responsibly carbon offset program.
- 85% of chemicals used by hotel staff to clean are considered environmentally friendly.
- Hotel is smoke-free.
- Food and Beverage Team cares for a garden of fresh herbs and vegetables on premises, used to prepare farm-to-table meals.
- Culinary Team prioritizes sustainable sourcing by using local produce, organic free-range meats, and cage-free eggs, all aligned with California Prop 12 and Marriott's Responsible Sourcing guidelines.

Energy Efficiency

- EV charging stations: Nine (9) EV Connect Level 2 stations.
- Free cooling systems, using 15% less energy.
- Energy efficient hot water boilers, saving 12% on consumption.
- Eliminated HPS bulbs by using over 6,000 LED light bulbs in public areas and guest rooms, as well as energy-saving LED signage, parking, and landscape lighting.
- Converted air handlers and pumps to energy efficient VFD (Variable Frequency Drive).

Recycling

- Hotel recycling effort in place for plastic, cardboard, aluminum, paper, soap, florescent bulbs, and batteries from meetings, offices, and guest rooms.
- Food and Beverage incorporates eco-friendly practices to reduce food waste.
- Surplus food donated to Orange County's "Food Finders" and 7 local in-need food shelters.

Water Use

- Water softeners installed to use less salt and water.
- Rain sensors are on irrigation clocks, and watering is reduced to two days weekly.
- Water saving shower heads and aerators installed in all guest rooms.
- Hotel participates in Marriott's "Linen Reuse Program" – a global effort to encourage guests to reuse linens during their stay.
